

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
AMONG
STOCKTON UNIVERSITY, CAMDEN COUNTY COLLEGE AND CAMDEN'S PROMISE CHARTER
SCHOOL**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made as of April 30, 2021 (the "Effective Date") by and among Camden's Promise Charter School ("Camden's Promise Charter School"), a public charter school in the City of Camden, New Jersey, Stockton University ("Stockton"), a New Jersey public institution of higher education, Camden County College ("Camden County College"), a New Jersey public institution of higher education, and Camden County Charter School District ("Camden County Charter School District"), a public school district in Camden, New Jersey.

- graduate from Camden Academy with an earned high school diploma;
- earn a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better (students with GPAs below 3.0 will be reviewed on an individual basis); and
- satisfy all other admissions application requirements.

Or

- Students will successfully complete the Camden County College, College Now Program earning an Associate of Arts degree by the end of their senior year of high school

Or

- If a student does not meet the above minimum admissions requirements, the student will be conditionally accepted to Stockton and encouraged to initially matriculate at Camden County College Transfer Pathways partnership.



- waive the undergraduate admission application fee;
- provide on-site personal admissions advisement at the Charter Academy for prospective students and parents;
- provide on-site general college search and financial aid workshops and presentations at the Charter Academy; and
- award competitive academic and partnership scholarships to qualified Camden Academy

- Provide Camden Academy with a universal release form to distribute to their students for signatures that will authorize Camden County College to provide Camden Academy with student grade reports.

Daguerre-type Scholarship

Stockton will provide institutional academic and merit scholarships to qualified Camden Academy graduates. These scholarships are renewable for four years, provided the student remains

the Stockton. When a scholarship is awarded, Stockton will inform the student of the GPA requirements to ensure renewal of the scholarship. In accordance with the terms and condition of

- joint public relations student recruiting marketing and promotion opportunities;

- joint grant-funding opportunities;
- visiting faculty lectures and professional presentation exchanges;

- student collaboration and peer mentoring;
- facility and other resource sharing opportunities;
