All Classics majors are urged to include in their educat on, if they can, a semester of study in Italy or Greece, and General Studies courses, as available, in mythology (e.g., GAH 1401 Classical Myth and Legend), folklore or ancient daily life (e.g., GAH 1304 Daily Life in Ancient Rome).

A minimum grade of C or bet er is required for all program and cognate courses counted toward the 64 program and cognate credits required for graduat on.

GENERAL STUDIES REOUIREMENT: 32 credits
