The incumbent senator enjoys strong name recognition and favorable ratings in the district, with 67 percent saying their opinion of him is very or somewhat favorable, with about 20 percent having a somewhat or very unfavorable opinion of Whelan. Only 11 percent were not familiar with Whelan, the former mayor of Atlantic City.

In contrast, 46 percent of respondents said they were not

Methodology

Interviews were conducted at the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy's Stockton Polling Institute, by live interviewers calling from the Stockton College campus. The poll was conducted with 596 likely voters from Sept. 7-
