

Poll indicates promising future for Atlantic City

ATLANTIC CITY - While reports indicate that the number of visitors to Atlantic City may be down, experts say that based on a recent poll Atlantic City's future seems promising.

In a poll released today by the Lloyd D. Levenson Institute of Gaming, Hospitality and Tourism, 81% of New Jersey gamblers say they will visit Atlantic City as many times as they did last year, while 10% say they intend to visit more often. But the most promising indicator may be that the number of gamblers that intend to try online gaming is triple that of the number that have actually already used the casinos' internet gaming sites.
